A public hearing will be held by the Tri-Basin Natural Resources District (NRD) Board of Directors on February 12, 2019 at 1:30 PM in the Board Room at the Tri-Basin NRD Office at 1723 Burlington Street in Holdrege, Nebraska. This hearing is being held to receive testimony from the public about whether to designate portions of the district for groundwater quality management, particularly: in Phelps County County, portions of Township 7N, R 17 W (Anderson), particularly sections 1-15, 22-27 and 34-36, as Phase II for groundwater quality management. This designation is being considered because groundwater nitrate levels in wells sampled by Tri-Basin NRD in this township have exceeded 9 parts per million for three years. This township, therefore meets criteria in the Natural Resources District rules and regulations (rule 3.1.2) for designation as a phase II groundwater quality management area.

At said time and place, testimony will be received from all interested persons. Individuals with disabilities may request auxiliary aids and service necessary for participation by contacting the Tri-Basin NRD at (308) 995-6688.
